## CELEBRATING THE Strength, wisdom & beauty OF WOMEN 50S, 60S, 70S +

There are more women aged 50+ than ever before, and it's time to celebrate the beauty and wisdom of the women in this sisterhood. I turned 50 at the end of 2019 and far from feeling "over the hill" I actually felt like I was just coming into my own! I launched this 50over50 project in January 2020 with the goal to photograph 50 women over 50 years old and celebrate them and their stories through a gallery exhibition and magazine. Through the delays of the pandemic and other commitments, it's morphed into something more than I could have imagined back then and there's a community building around this project.

I've gained a lot of insights through working with these women who have chosen to participate in the project. It goes much deeper than having a beautiful portrait. Everyone has their story; maybe it's overcoming a health challenge, leaving a difficult relationship, changing careers, or becoming an empty nester. But underneath all of them is a common theme of transition and a declaration of "it's MY turn now" and stepping forward to claim the life and the impact that they want. There's a powerful energy that's released when you get a bunch of women together who have all stepped into this space.

I love this quote by Brené Brown about this time of women's lives where she says, "I think midlife is when the universe gently places her hands upon your shoulders, pulls you close, and whispers in your ear: *I'm not screwing around. It's time.*" She's not talking about time to die, but time to get going with your dreams, to love yourself and stop caring about what other people think. Stop waiting for permission. Just go do it. Make your mark. Live the life you want to live. <u>It's time</u>. I've found that this message is a running thread through all these women's stories. It's been an inspiration.



In some ways I've been a photographer all my life, from using a pin hole camera in first grade and watching the images appear like magic in the darkroom, to a high school flirtation with being a National Geographic Photographer. Since 2006 I've had the privilege to help women and their families document their milestones, their relationships, and the love they share by focusing on the thing that makes us uniquely human and life worth living – connection. Connection with our best selves and with those we love.

My background has been eclectic – anthropology, museum curation, education, community development (here and abroad) – and all of it at its core has been about connection, history and making my corner of the world a better place. Sometimes I felt like I was zig zagging my way through life, even though as each next step unfolded it felt right at the time. Now I know without a doubt that all of those experiences have brought me right where I'm supposed to be. I'm right here, living and loving my people and doing the work that I was meant to do.

#### **EXECUTIVE BIO FOR TRACY MONTARTI**




